

**Archbald Borough Council Meeting  
Wednesday, September 19, 2018**

A public meeting to discuss its Municipal Separated Storm Sewer System (MS4) Pollution Reduction Plan was held prior to council meeting. Stephanie Milewski from Barry Isett & Associates Inc. presented MS4 Pollutant Reduction Plan. An outline of this plan is attached to these minutes.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Joseph Simon. A moment of Silence was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call Burke, Gilgallon, Mancuso, Owen, Grandinetti and Hart present. Mayor Barrett was in attendance.

Presentation by Mayor Barrett to Judy Rudalavage and Jean Yesalavage for their hard work with the Eynon Christmas Lights Committee. Both Judy and Jean were given a key to the city.

**Public Input**

Nancy Edmunds asked who owns the land across from 752 Lori Drive in Archbald. Mayor Barrett stated the borough manager Jack Giordano may information on this. Ms. Edmunds asked if there will be a controllers report every month. Mr. Simon stated there will be. Megan from Foxtail Circle asked about street lighting in her development. Mr. Simon stated the papers are signed with PP&L and we are waiting for call on the date to be installed.

**Council Reports**

Gilgallon stated at 166 Spruce Street in Archbald there is a car sitting there. Mr. Lemoncelli stated he contacted Highway Auto to tow it. He also stated at 183 Spruce Street in Archbald there is garbage siting in the back of the house. Mr. Gilgallon asked Mr. Lemoncelli to look at this.

Burke had nothing at this time.

Mancuso stated last house on West Street the grass is very high and 427 Church Street the yard is a mess. Mr. Mancuso asked Mr. Lemoncelli to look at these address.

Owen stated the controller report should be on the motion to be approved. Mrs. Owen stated the Eynon Archbald Lions Club will hold its 9<sup>th</sup> annual Harvest Fest on September 30<sup>th</sup> at the Archbald Borough Building. Mrs. Owen stated the Santa Trail will be December 1<sup>st</sup>.

Mayor Barrett stated the police will be running their car seat and seat belt stops.

**Motions**

Motion by Owen, second by Grandinetti to approve the minutes of August 15, 2018 regular Council meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Owen, second by Gilgallon to accept Reports – Treasurer, Building Inspector and Mayor’s Report. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Gilgallon, second by Hart authorizing payment of August HNB General Fund bills totaling \$219,389.47, Memorial Park Account bill in the amount of \$75.00 and Staback Park Maintenance Account expenditure of \$29,162.23. Roll call vote, Mancuso, Burke, Gilgallon, Grandinetti, Hart and Simon for it, Owen against. 6-1 vote, motion carried.

Motion by Owen, second by Hart to adopt a Resolution authorizing the Lackawanna County Commissioners to submit an application on behalf of the Borough for FFY 2018 CDBG funds in the amount of \$117,180.00. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Gilgallon, second by Hart to approve Duda Actuarial Consulting calculations of the 2019 Minimum Municipal Obligations for the Archbald Borough Police Pension Plan in the amount of \$89,097.00. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Hart, second by Gilgallon to approve Duda Actuarial Consulting calculations of the 2019 Minimum Municipal Obligations for the Archbald Borough Non-Uniformed Pension Plan in the amount of \$34,793.00. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Owen, second by Mancuso authorizing submission of a request to the US ARMY TACOM Life Cycle Management Command for a decommissioned piece of combat equipment for display in the Archbald Borough Veterans Monument Park on Kennedy Drive. Archbald Borough Council by doing so acknowledges that it will assume all responsibility for the upkeep and safety of the display item and understands that the equipment cannot be placed on privately owned property. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Owen, second by Gilgallon to approve submission of the Borough’s proposed Pollution Reduction Plan to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection upon termination of the 30 day public review and comment period. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Gilgallon, second by Mancuso, second by to authorize the Borough Solicitor, Planning Consultant and Borough Manager to proceed with property owner notification and setting a date for a Public Hearing regarding the proposed Zoning Map changes. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Owen, second by Grandinetti to adjourn. All in favor, motion carried.
