

Archbald Borough Council Meeting
Wednesday, October 17, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Joseph Simon. A moment of Silence was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call Burke, Gilgallon, Mancuso, Owen, Grandinetti and Hart present. Mayor Barrett was in attendance. Treasurer was not in attendance.

Public Input

Nancy Edmonds 752 Lori Drive stated there is an error in the Controllers report, and she would like to talk to him. Ms. Edmonds had questions about the Treasures report also. Treasurer Rudalavage was not present at meeting and Ms. Edmonds stated she will ask her next month. Meg Noodlemen 295 Fox Tail Circle asked Mr. Giordano if he has heard back from PP&L. She stated she spoke to Don at PP& L and she was told the poles and lights would be available soon. The PP&L employees are in Florida and should be back in a week to start the work. Ms. Noodlemen also asked if emergency crews are aware of the numbering in Foxtail Circle. Mr. Giordano stated Police Chief Trently and Fire Chief Harvey are aware of the numbering there.

Council Reports

Gilgallon stated the planning commission had no one for October.

Burke thanked Mayor Barrett for getting the blight committee together again.

Mancuso stated the gas company did work on Lawrence Street and Stafursky fixed the road. He stated that Stafursky should come back and seal the blacktop before winter.

Owen had nothing at this time.

Grandinetti thanked DPW for cleaning around the shifting shanty so now the blocks can be laid.

Hart stated Notre Dame Club will have a dinner Saturday. Mr. Hart stated this time of the year everyone should check their smoke detectors.

Motions

Motion by Owen, second by Gilgallon to approve the minutes of September 19, 2018 regular Council meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Gilgallon, second by Burke to accept Reports – Treasurer, Building Inspector, Controller and Mayor’s Report. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Gilgallon, second by Hart authorizing payment of September HNB General Fund bills totaling \$299,375.66 and Memorial Park Account bill in the amount of \$75.00. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Owen, second by Burke to adopt an **Ordinance** using the Quality of Life and violations ticket process in the Borough of Archbald. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Mancuso, second by Gilgallon to approve a **Resolution** opposing the transfer of Earned Income Tax collection from the local county collection committees as set up by Act 32 to the PA Department of Revenue. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Owen, second by Burke to approve a **Resolution** authorizing the Borough to submit a Local Share Account – Monroe County Grant application on behalf of the Valley View School District in the amount of \$400,000 for the Valley View High School Roof Repair Project. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Mancuso, second by Gilgallon authorizing the Borough Solicitor to draft an Ordinance adopting and approving a contractual Agreement with Building Inspection Underwriters, Inc. of Pennsylvania as sole third party UCC code inspectors for Archbald Borough. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.


