

Archbald Borough Council Meeting
Wednesday, January 19, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Joseph Simon. A moment of Silence was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call Owen, Mancuso, Burke, Gilgallon, Grandinetti and Hart present. Mayor Barrett was in attendance. Treasurer/Secretary Rudalavage was not in attendance.



Motion by Grandinetti, second by Burke to adjourn. All in favor, motion carried.


