Ms. Edmunds asked Mr. O'Connor if legally the council can adopt an ordinance that a copy of the tax collector report and controller report be put into the monthly reports. Atty. O'Connor stated he will look into it.

Burke stated the DPW, Police and all volunteers do a top notch job in this borough and also wished all a Happy Thanksgiving.

Owen asked Mr. Simon if the abandoned vehicle at the trailer court were taken care of. Mr. Simon stated the borough car is out if service but stated maybe the Police can take Mr. Lemoncelli to the trailer court to tag the vehicles. Mrs. Owen stated the Halloween event was a big success. Tree Lighting will be Saturday Nov. 24th at 4pm corner Main Street and Betty Street. Santa Trail will be December 1st at 11:35am. Motion by Gilgallon, second by Hart authorizing payment of October HNB General Fund bills totaling \$147,274.53, Memorial Park Account bills in the amount of \$150.00 and Arts Grant Account bill for \$500.00. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Gilgallon, second by Burke to present the proposed FY2019 Budget for Public Inspection with actual adoption at the December monthly meeting of Borough Council. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Gilgallon, second by Burke to adopt an Ordinance amending Ordinance #4 of 2004 adopting the provisions of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Construction Code Act and attendant regulations, and designating Building Inspection Underwriters of Pennsylvania, Inc. as the Borough’s sole official building inspector under the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Hart, second by Owen to adopt Young Lungs at Play Policy. Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.




Motion by Owen, second by Mancuso to adjourn. All in favor, motion carried.
