

**Archbald Borough Council Meeting
Wednesday, July 17, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Joseph Simon. A moment of Silence was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call Owen, Mancuso, Grandinetti, Burke, Gilgallon and Hart present. Mayor Barrett was in attendance.

Public Input

Debbie Seboldt 447 Delaware Street has a concern about her neighbor at 451 Delaware Street. Ms. Seboldt stated her neighbor's grain pip comes out to the road causing lots of water to freeze in the winter and holes to form. Mr. Simon stated the borough will take a look at it. Kyle Mullens introduced himself to the borough and stated his services will be in Archbald on July 26th from 11am to 1pm, August 21st from 11am to 1pm and September 18th from 11am to 1pm. Mr. Mullen's also stated he has a new district office on the Burke Bypass in Olyphant phone number 570-383-9795.

Nancy Edmonds asked how far away from a building can fireworks be done. Mr. Turlip stated it is 150 Feet from any structure. Ms. Edmonds also asked if she would need a permit for her driveway, Mr. Simon stated she does not.

Mayor Barrett extended her condolences to the Smith family on the passing of Colleen. The borough will certainly miss her. She stated that next month the chief will be at the meeting to speak.

Hart stated that fire companies in the borough do not solicit through shone only by mail, so if you get a phone call please hang up. He also stated with the forecasted heat, please check on neighbors and elderly people who may need help.

Mancuso stated DPW is doing a great job patching even with the extreme heat.

Gilgallon stated the ATV are still an issue in the borough. The mayor stated the chief is aware and is in discussion about this issue.

Roll call vote, all in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Grandinetti, second by Owen to approve Rep. Mullins' use of Council Chambers to conduct an outreach session on Friday July 26, 2019 11:00 am to 1:00 pm. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Gilgallon, second by Burke accepting the resignation of Walter Loff, Jr. from the Archbald Zoning Hearing Board. All in favor, motion carried.


