Public Comment (General Items)

<u>Tom Owen-</u>1196 North State Street Archbald, Pa 18403. Tom addressed council, and asked how many people would be employed if the data center goes through. What will be used for cooling, and did they consider that the school is nearby.

<u>Jerry Gillette</u>- 111 N. Cougar Drive Archbald, Pa 18403- Jerry asked council if they had done any investigation if the data center is built, and asked about the noise, and the pollution.

<u>Kristen Tratthen</u>- 125 Falcon Lane Archbald, Pa 18403- Kristen addressed council, and asked when and if there is a meeting on the data center is it open to the public.

<u>Kyle Callejas</u> 211 Laurel Street Archbald, Pa 18403- Kyle addressed council, and asked that they don't rush through anything, and take the time to do some research on the data center.

Council Comments-

Laura Lewis-Laura addressed the residents who attended the council meeting, and try to assure them that council will do their due diligence for the community.

Erin Owen- Erin spoke on the data center, and her concerns, and effects it will have Pollution, Noise, water waste. Erin addressed Council President Dave Moran how many meetings were held in the Borough Building that she was unaware of, and how many council members were there. Erin is concerned for the safety of the children who will be attending the schools that will be in close vicinity of the data center, and the junk cars that will be towed away. Erin spoke she is on the fence of the data center.

<u>President Dave Moran</u>- President Moran addressed the residents and assured them that as President of council, and every council member Borough Manager Dan Markey, and Zoning Officer Brian Dulay will do the research, and education themselves on data centers. President Moran spoke on the Zoning Ordinance - SALDO (Subdivision and Land Ordinance) which is an Ordinance that must be followed in Archbald Borough.

<u>Solicitor Jay O'Connor</u> - spoke on the Zoning Ordinance on the data center. If you own property in Archbald, you must meet the requirements of the SALDO. The Solicitor also stated that data center use is currently listed as principally permitted in most zones, meaning if they come in with applications and comply with all zoning and SALDO laws, they are currently permitted by right to construct data centers. When the draft ordinance is returned by the Lackawanna County Regional Planning Commission, we can schedule a public hearing on the amendment to the zoning ordinance, which only adds definitions and changes data center usage to "Conditional Use".
